








A shortage of doctors in the system








Average age of specialists in South Africa = 55 years



Epidemic of lifestyle diseases




Increasing disease burden in medical schemes

Young and healthy lives drop out of schemes






Impact of adverse selection: R13.5bn – ~23% of total contributions for open medical schemes



Growth in claimants for high-cost drugs exceeds growth in chronic claimants




Increases proportional expenditure on high-cost drugs




Number of DHMS top-claiming families required to deplete competitor reserves





Top claiming families: Total 2012 risk spend per policy, ranked by spend




Mortality curves by Vitality status: Standard lives





Engaged members experienced lower costs per patient, shorter stays in hospital, and fewer admissions compared to all other groups



Impact of fitness engagement on hospital admissions and costs





Improved outcomes and savings




- Glucose meter connects directly to phone
- Readings are transmitted to a web URL
- Data is accessible for both patients and doctors
- Doctor is alerted automatically if readings are out of range

- Approximately 55,000 diabetics on the scheme
- Total cost of R293million per annum

Voluntary programme designed to coordinate the **long-term care** for the **sickest** Discovery Health members






CCP Outcomes: Post above-knee amputation for a poorly controlled diabetic





Cross-subsidies across the plan range are actuarially sound, beneficial for sicker members and sustainable in the long term

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






DHMS has a lower cost inflation than all other open schemes



% Growth in pabpm costs (2008 – 2011)







HealthID: Enabling quality care





Over 1 000 practitioners have adopted HealthID



Over 120 000 member consents to date

Case Study 1: Dermatologist

- Member suffering from a rash goes to the doctor
- Using HealthID, the doctor learns that the member had been prescribed with other medication – side effects of this drug being the outbreak of a skin rash
- Doctor substitutes the existing medication and no additional medication or tests are required

Case Study 2: Anaesthetist

- During pre-op rounds, the anaesthetist confirms all patients' medication and dosages
- Using HealthID, he learns of incorrect information provided by the patient on the name of medication used
- This information potentially saved a DHMS member's life as the medication could have adversely affected the outcome of the operation











