| 0012 | Blood glucose screening | Maximum of R280 for a beneficiary every twelve months on all plans | R 58.50 |
| 0013 | Blood cholesterol screening | | R 97.40 |
| 0015 | Blood pressure monitoring | | R 58.50 |
| 0021 | Administration of an intramuscular or subcutaneous injection | | R 78.30 |

Should your system not allow these claim procedure codes, your providers may utilise dummy NAPPI codes instead, by adding zeros to the end of the code, for example:

- 0016 becomes 001600000
- 0017 becomes 001700000
