Merger



- Nampak Medical Scheme (NMS) approached DHMS during 2011 to consider a merger in 2013
- High level statistics:

As at 31 December 2011:	DHMS	NMS
Reserves per beneficiary (31 Dec 2011)	R3 141	R12 763
Average age	32.75	37.47
Number of beneficiaries	2 354 351	11 500

Merger



- Calculations were done in the last quarter of 2011
 - Impact on DHMS of a merger with NMS was modelled taking into account
 - Demographic factors
 - Plan mapping
 - Current claims experience
 - Accumulated funds requirement of R120.5 million estimated
 - Actual NMS accumulated funds as at 31 December 2011 of R147.8 million
- The actual level of accumulated funds compensates DHMS for the worse demographic profile of NMS
 - For at least 5 years
 - Depending on how long members remain on the default benefit options

Proposal



- As the NMS accumulated funds exceed the actuarial requirement, it is proposed that the merger be approved subject to certain conditions:
 - At least R120.5 million of reserves be transferred to DHMS at the date of the merger
 - Merger to take place by 1 January 2013. If later, the conditions must be re-evaluated
 - Option mapping will be used to identify default options for those members who do not explicitly exercise an option
 - There is no material corporate activity within the employer before the date of the proposed amalgamation
